Description:

Organic waste on campus mainly consists of food waste, vegetable peelings, fallen leaves, and other biodegradable materials generated through daily campus activities and seasonal cleaning. The institute has a cooperation arrangement with a local farm, under which clean vegetable peelings are provided for livestock feeding, while the farm supplies dairy products in return.

Part of the collected leaves is also transferred to the farm, while another part is retained on campus for composting and natural decomposition, which contributes to the production of natural organic fertilizer for green areas. This practice helps reduce the volume of organic waste sent to disposal and supports environmentally responsible waste management on campus.

This activity supports SDG 12 – Responsible Consumption and Production by promoting the reuse and composting of organic waste, SDG 13 – Climate Action by reducing organic waste sent to disposal and lowering related emissions, and SDG 11 – Sustainable Cities and Communities by supporting a cleaner and more sustainable campus environment.
