Description:

Last year, the total volume of toxic waste produced at Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages was very low, as the institute does not have chemical-intensive laboratories or industrial facilities. The toxic waste generated on campus was mainly related to routine educational, administrative, and maintenance activities.

According to the collected data, the institute produced 0.10 tons of toxic waste last year. This amount mainly included small quantities of used batteries, fluorescent lamps, printer cartridges, electronic waste, and other minor hazardous materials used in offices, classrooms, and service areas. No laboratory chemical waste was produced during the reporting period.

All toxic waste materials were collected separately from general waste and handled with special attention to safety. Used batteries, lamps, cartridges, and electronic items were stored in designated areas and prepared for appropriate disposal or transfer to authorized waste management organizations. These measures helped the institute prevent unsafe disposal, reduce environmental risks, and support environmentally responsible campus waste management.
