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Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages applies safe and responsible procedures for the collection and temporary storage of toxic and hazardous waste generated on campus. Although the Institute does not produce large-scale toxic waste, several potentially hazardous waste items are managed separately, including used batteries, fluorescent lamps, printer cartridges, electronic waste, chemical cleaning materials, and medical or sanitary waste from the first-aid room.

These types of waste are not mixed with general municipal waste. They are collected in designated containers or stored in separate temporary storage areas to prevent environmental pollution and protect human health. Used batteries and printer cartridges are collected in labelled boxes, fluorescent lamps are stored separately to avoid mercury contamination, and electronic waste such as old computers, monitors, keyboards, cables, and printers is kept in a designated area for further repair, reuse, recycling, or safe disposal.

Medical and sanitary waste from the campus first-aid room is placed in a special container and handled with care, while chemical cleaning materials are stored safely to prevent leakage and contamination. This system supports the Institute's commitment to sustainable campus management and reduces environmental risks.
