Description:

An eco-action was organized on March 22, 2025, under the slogan "Unite for Nature!" through a joint initiative between Andijon State Institute of Foreign Languages and the Andijon Regional Party Organization of the Uzbekistan Ecological Party. The event was officially opened by D.A. Rustamov — party member, deputy of the Andijon Regional Council, and Rector of Andijon State Institute of Foreign Languages — who outlined the objectives of the campaign and called on all participants to unite in addressing environmental challenges. Description:
