Description:

Paper and plastic waste generated on campus this year mainly consisted of office paper, study materials, cardboard, soft plastic, and hard plastic produced through educational, administrative, and daily campus activities. Compared with the previous year, the total amount of paper and plastic waste decreased due to improved waste separation practices, wider use of electronic books and digital learning resources, and the use of the HEMIS system for document management and administrative processes.

These measures helped reduce paper consumption across the campus. In addition, the use of refill points, reusable cups, and reusable bottles contributed to reducing single-use plastic waste. Recyclable paper, cardboard, and plastic waste collected on campus are transferred to the Andijan regional branch of UZVTORTSVETMET for further recycling and proper processing.

These activities support SDG 12 – Responsible Consumption and Production by reducing waste generation and promoting recycling, and SDG 13 – Climate Action by lowering the environmental impact of campus operations.
