Water Recycling Program at Andijan state institute of foreign languages

Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages is developing a water recycling and water reuse program to support sustainable campus management and reduce unnecessary freshwater consumption. The program focuses on monitoring water use, improving water efficiency in campus facilities, collecting rainwater flow, and reusing non-potable water for green area maintenance.

As shown in the evidence, the institute uses water meters to monitor campus water consumption and ensure more efficient control of water resources. Water-efficient facilities, including taps and washbasins, are installed in campus buildings to reduce excessive water use. The campus also has drainage and rainwater flow areas that can support future rainwater collection and reuse practices. Reused or non-potable water is applied mainly for garden irrigation, landscaping, and maintenance of green zones. These practices help preserve trees, lawns, flowerbeds, and other green areas while reducing the need for clean tap water. Regular inspection and maintenance of the water supply system are also carried out to prevent leakage, reduce water loss, and improve the reliability of campus water infrastructure.

The water recycling program contributes to reducing freshwater consumption, improving efficient campus management, protecting the environment, and raising awareness among students and staff about responsible water use. In the future, the institute plans to further strengthen this program by expanding rainwater collection facilities and introducing more efficient irrigation systems.
