[5.4] The total number of vehicles (cars and motorcycles with combustion engines) divided by the total campus population (TR.1)

Formula: $(5.1 + 5.2 + 5.3) / (1.12 + 1.14) = (3 + 33 + 10) / 4,744 = 46 / 4,744 = 0.0097$

Description:

The vehicle-to-population ratio at Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages is 0.0097, which is significantly below 0.045. This result shows that the number of combustion-engine vehicles on campus is very low compared with the total campus population. The calculation is based on 3 cars actively used and managed by the university, 33 cars entering the university daily, and 10 motorcycles entering the university daily, making a total of 46 vehicles for a campus population of 4,744 people. The institute supports sustainable transportation by limiting unnecessary vehicle access, encouraging more efficient campus mobility, and maintaining transport-related measures that reduce congestion, fuel use, and emissions. This contributes to SDG 11 - Sustainable Cities and Communities, SDG 13 - Climate Action, and SDG 3 - Good Health and Well-being by supporting a safer, cleaner, and more environmentally responsible campus environment.
