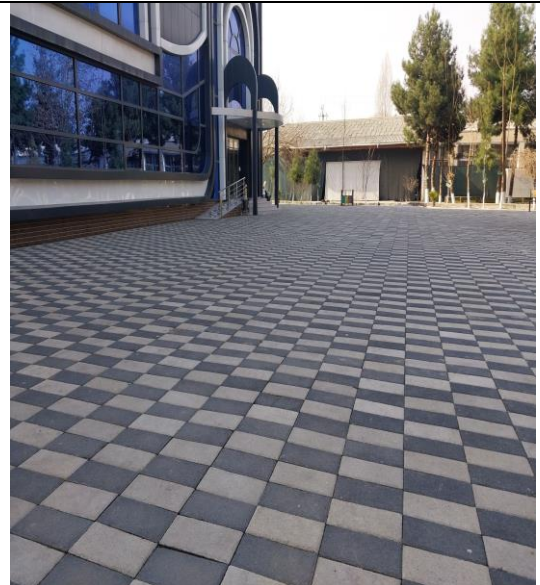

### Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages has established a comprehensive Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) policy as part of its broader commitment to sustainable, low-carbon campus transportation. The institute actively promotes the use of zero-emission vehicles and non-motorized



transport across its campus, creating a cleaner, safer, and more environmentally friendly mobility environment for all students and staff.

**Cyclist and Pedestrian-Friendly Campus:** All areas of the Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages campus are designed to be cyclist and pedestrian friendly. The campus features 5,100 meters of dedicated pedestrian pathways and bicycle lanes, clearly marked with white line separators and equipped with 198 lighting units to ensure safety at all times of day. 3 car-free zones have been designated across the campus to provide vehicle-free paths exclusively for cyclists and pedestrians, minimizing the risk of accidents and encouraging active, sustainable mobility.

**Speed Limit Policy:** A strict internal speed limit is enforced on all campus roads to ensure the safety of pedestrians and cyclists. This policy creates a safer environment for non-motorized transport users and discourages the excessive use of private motor vehicles within the campus territory.

**Bicycle Infrastructure and Support:** The institute provides 100 bicycles for free rental to students and staff, supported by 3 dedicated bicycle parking stations strategically located across the campus. This infrastructure encourages cycling as a primary mode of short-distance transportation and reduces reliance on private motor vehicles.

**Zero Emission Vehicle Fleet:** The institute operates and supports a growing fleet of zero emission vehicles across its campus, as detailed in the table below:

**Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure:** To support the growing zero emission vehicle fleet, the institute has installed 2 electric vehicle (EV) charging stations on campus, providing convenient charging facilities for electric automobiles, scooters, and other electric vehicles used by staff and visitors.

**Awareness and Promotion:** The institute actively promotes zero emission vehicle use through seminars, training sessions, and social media campaigns, raising awareness among students and staff about the environmental and health benefits of switching to clean, zero-emission transportation alternatives.

Through its comprehensive ZEV policy, Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages demonstrates a strong institutional commitment to reducing its carbon footprint, improving air quality on campus, and building a truly sustainable transportation ecosystem for its entire community.
