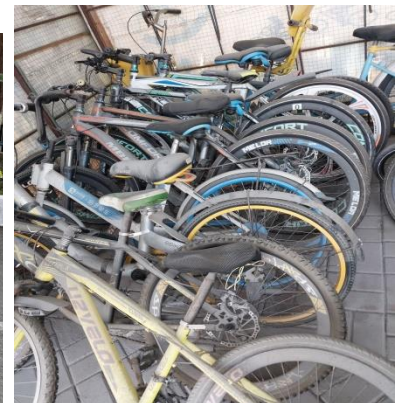
[5.15] Number of Transportation Initiatives to Decrease Private Vehicles on Campus (TR.7)

Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages has implemented effective transportation initiatives aimed at reducing private vehicle use on campus and promoting sustainable, eco-friendly commuting among students and staff.

Shuttle/Bus Service on Campus: The institute operates a total of 15 buses serving both internal and external routes:

3 Eco Line electric buses operate exclusively within the campus territory, providing clean, zero-emission transportation between key campus facilities, academic buildings, and student dormitories. These buses are fully electric, charged using electricity, making them a carbon-neutral and environmentally responsible mode of internal campus transportation. This initiative significantly reduces fuel consumption and greenhouse gas emissions within the campus grounds.

15 buses operate along the Boburshoh Street route, connecting the institute to surrounding areas of the city. This public transport service offers students and staff a reliable, affordable, and environmentally friendly alternative to private vehicle commuting, effectively reducing traffic congestion and carbon emissions in the campus vicinity.

Free Bicycle Rental on Campus: The institute provides a fleet of 100 bicycles available for free rental to students and staff. This initiative encourages eco-friendly short-distance travel within and around the campus, promoting a healthier and more sustainable lifestyle among the campus community.

Bicycle Parking Facilities: The institute has installed 3 dedicated bicycle parking stations at strategic locations across the campus for students and staff who commute using their own personal bicycles. These secure and conveniently located parking facilities accommodate a large number of bicycles, encouraging more people to choose cycling as their primary mode of transportation. This



initiative further reduces reliance on private motor vehicles and contributes to a greener, more sustainable campus environment.

Through these integrated transportation initiatives, Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages demonstrates a strong commitment to building a greener, more sustainable campus transportation system while actively minimizing its environmental footprint.
