

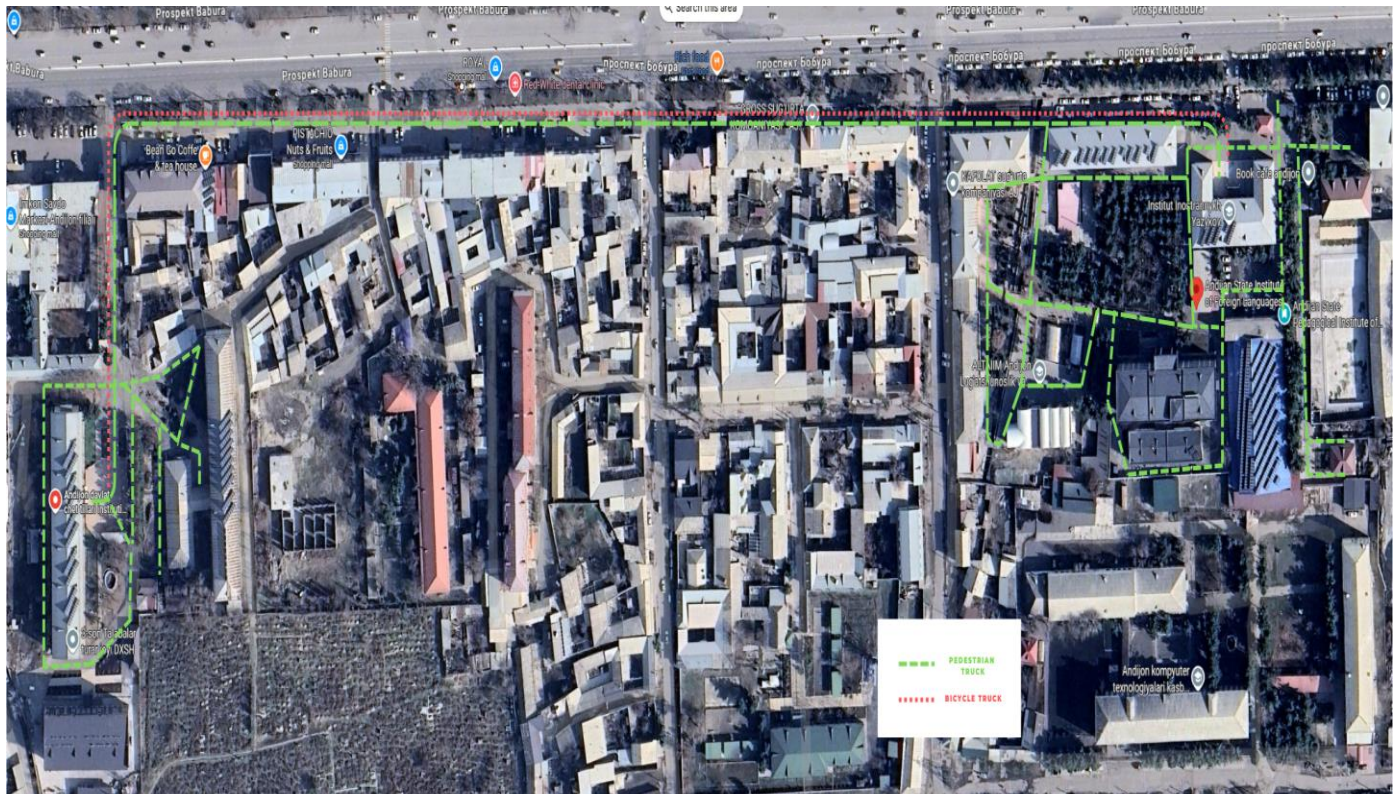
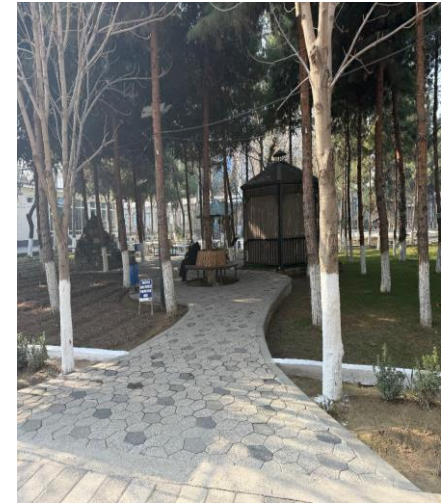

[5.16] Pedestrian Path Policy on Campus (TR.8)





Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages has implemented a comprehensive pedestrian path policy aimed at ensuring safety, accessibility, and sustainability across its campus.

Separation of Roads and Pedestrian Paths: All pedestrian pathways on campus are clearly marked and separated from vehicle roads using white line markings. The total length of designated pedestrian pathways covers 5,100 meters, providing a well-defined and safe walking network throughout the entire campus territory.

Ramps and Guiding Blocks for Persons with Physical Disabilities: The campus pathways are equipped with ramps and tactile guiding blocks specifically designed to accommodate pedestrians with physical disabilities, ensuring full accessibility and inclusivity for all campus users.



Street Lighting for Pedestrians at Night: The institute has installed a total of 271 lighting units across the campus to ensure pedestrian safety during nighttime hours, distributed as follows:

- 33 solar-powered street lamps — energy-efficient, carbon-neutral lighting harvesting solar energy during the day and automatically illuminating pathways at night.
- 138 pathway lamps — installed directly along pedestrian walkways to ensure continuous, well-lit routes for students and staff.
- 100 decorative lamps — enhancing the campus environment while contributing to overall nighttime visibility and safety.

This integrated lighting system, combined with clearly marked pedestrian paths and accessible infrastructure, reflects the institute's strong commitment to sustainable, safe, and inclusive campus transportation.
