Description:

At Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages (ASIFL), a number of study programs contribute to sustainability through education, intercultural communication, ethical language use, inclusive teaching practices, and community-oriented professional preparation. Although these programs are primarily focused on foreign languages, literature, linguistics, translation, and pedagogy, they also support sustainability by promoting quality education, social inclusion, cultural understanding, responsible communication, and skills relevant to sustainable development.

The Faculty of English Language and Literature offers programs such as Foreign Language and Literature (English) and Linguistics (English), which strengthen critical thinking, communication ethics, and research capacity. The Faculty of Philology, English Philology, Teaching Methodology and Translation Studies offers programs including Philology and Language Teaching (English), Tour Guiding and Interpreting / Translation (English), Foreign Language in Preschool and Primary Education, and Comparative Linguistics, Linguistic Translation Studies (English), which contribute to sustainability through language education, translation for public communication, responsible tourism,



and early educational development. The Faculty of Romano-Germanic and Slavic Languages supports sustainability through programs such as Philology and Language Teaching (Russian), Foreign Language and Literature (German), and Foreign Language and Literature (French) by promoting multilingualism, intercultural dialogue, and socially responsible education.

These study programs align especially with SDG 4 (Quality Education), while also contributing to SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities), SDG 16 (Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions), and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals).
