Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages strengthens sustainability culture through student-led eco-volunteering, environmental awareness campaigns, and incentive-based recognition of green initiatives. During the 2024–2025 academic year, the Institute organized eco-actions under the slogan “Let’s unite for nature!”, including a campus and community clean-up initiative titled “Waste-free Territory”, implemented by ASIFL eco-volunteer students. These activities aim to reduce littering, promote responsible waste practices, and develop long-term pro-environmental behavior among students.



To motivate student innovation and sustainability leadership, ASIFL launched a structured recognition and award framework. ASIFL held the “Honour – 2025” ceremony to acknowledge talented students for academic and creative achievements, innovative ideas, and research-driven contributions. Sustainability was explicitly integrated into the award system through the nomination “Author of the Best Eco-Project of the Academic Year.” Winners across key sustainability-oriented directions, including eco-volunteering and clean-environment actions, were officially recognized and received cash awards.

ASIFL further institutionalizes environmental engagement by announcing additional eco-nominations such as “Ecology Expert” and “Most Active Eco-Activist,” establishing a dedicated website section titled “Eco-active Students,” and initiating the EcoASIFL Eco-Club to coordinate continuous eco-project development, peer learning, and outreach.

In parallel, the Institute’s unit responsible for organizing talented students’ research activities continues sustainability-focused promotion and engagement within the “Eco-Innovations-2025” exhibition framework, supporting active student participation in innovative developments and project competitions. ASIFL also contributes to national greening priorities through the “Yashil Makon” nationwide initiative and the “Green Future” republican marathon. Within these programs, the Faculty of English Language and Literature promoted a dormitory-based green action by planting nearly 100 fruit and ornamental trees, improving campus greenery and supporting biodiversity-friendly landscaping.
