ECO-VOLUNTEERS
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Description:

At Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages (ASIFL), student organizations actively support sustainability through recurring campus and community initiatives. These activities are mainly coordinated by student-led eco-volunteering groups and the EcoASIFL student eco-club, with participation from faculty-based youth teams. The annual calendar typically includes clean-up campaigns (campus and neighborhood clean-ups), environmental awareness sessions, and student-led social media outreach promoting waste reduction and responsible consumption.

Key student-organized activities include “Waste-free Territory” eco-actions under the slogan “Let’s Unite for Nature!”, plogging-style clean-up events, dormitory and campus greening actions (tree planting and care), and youth engagement programmes such as the “Green Future” marathon. Students also organize exhibitions and idea-sharing events that promote eco-friendly solutions and

student creativity. These student-led initiatives contribute to a sustainability culture on campus by combining practical environmental action with education, communication, and peer motivation.

Examples of student organization activities conducted within a year:

Campus clean-up eco-actions

Community clean-up campaigns

“Waste-free Territory” eco-action

Plogging-style clean-up events

Tree planting campaigns

Dormitory greening activities

Campus flower and seedling planting activities

Environmental awareness talks

Peer-learning workshops on sustainability

Student-led social media campaigns on waste reduction

Eco-innovation exhibitions

Student idea competitions on eco-friendly solutions

In total, student organizations conduct approximately 12 sustainability-related activities per year. These activities support environmental awareness, responsible consumption, student engagement, and the development of a sustainability culture on campus.
