Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages (ASIFL) organizes and supports sustainability-oriented community service projects involving students, eco-volunteer groups, the EcoASIFL student eco-club, faculty youth teams, and campus departments. These projects connect classroom learning with practical environmental action and community outreach.

The projects include waste-free clean-up actions, plogging activities, tree planting and campus greening, water-saving awareness, eco-innovation activities, and student-led sustainability outreach. Through these initiatives, ASIFL students contribute to cleaner public spaces, responsible waste practices, biodiversity-friendly greening, environmental awareness, and sustainable community development.

The six community service projects listed above are implemented on campus and in nearby community areas with the participation of students and staff. They support SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 6 (Clean Water and Sanitation), SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), SDG 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production), SDG 13 (Climate Action), SDG 15 (Life on Land), and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals).
