

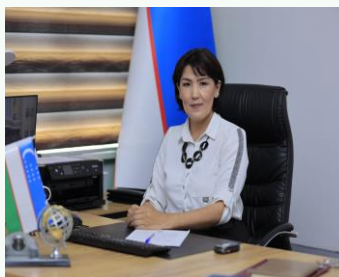
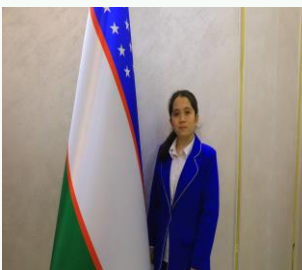

Institutional Structure and Supporting Unit

	Besh Muhim Tashabbus Markazi (Five Important Initiatives Center) This center is included as an institutional supporting unit for student engagement and SDG-oriented campus initiatives. It supports educational, cultural, social, volunteer, youth leadership and community-oriented activities that strengthen sustainability awareness among students and staff. Role in 7.10 evidence: supports the GreenMetric Working Group by organizing and documenting student-centered sustainability activities, awareness events, social projects and inclusive campus initiatives.

Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages (ASIFL) has a dedicated GreenMetric Sustainability Coordination Working Group responsible for coordinating sustainability evidence, institutional reporting, campus initiatives and SDG-related activities. The unit brings together staff members from sustainability documentation, information security and AI, international cooperation, finance, and student activity support in order to ensure that the institute's sustainability work is recorded, verified and presented in a systematic way. The working group is coordinated by Rahmonova Gulchehra as the main coordinator. Abdulla G'oyibberdiyev supports AI, information security and digital evidence management. Alisher Khoshimjonov supports international cooperation and SDG partnership activities. Nodirbek Bobajonov provides financial, invoice, budget and procurement evidence. Abdusattorova Begoyim assists with documentation, captions, photos, student activity records and evidence preparation. Together, these staff members form a functional coordination structure for UI GreenMetric reporting and campus sustainability implementation.

In addition to the five dedicated staff members, ASIFL includes Besh Muhim Tashabbus Markazi as a supporting institutional unit for student-centered sustainability activities. The center contributes to SDG-oriented campus life by supporting educational, cultural, volunteer, healthy lifestyle, youth leadership, inclusive participation and community engagement activities. Its work strengthens the social and educational dimensions of sustainability and helps connect GreenMetric reporting with real student participation.

ASIFL sustainability coordination also covers SDG-related activities organized by the institute, including green campus awareness, waste and resource-saving campaigns, student events, educational programs, international cooperation activities, digitalization initiatives, inclusive governance, and responsible financial documentation. These activities support the integration of sustainability into governance, education, student life, international partnerships, and campus operations. Number of dedicated staff members assigned to the unit or office responsible for coordinating sustainability initiatives on campus: 5 people. Supporting institutional unit: Besh Muhim Tashabbus Markazi.
