Rectorate, compliance staff, deans, departments and administrative units review reports.



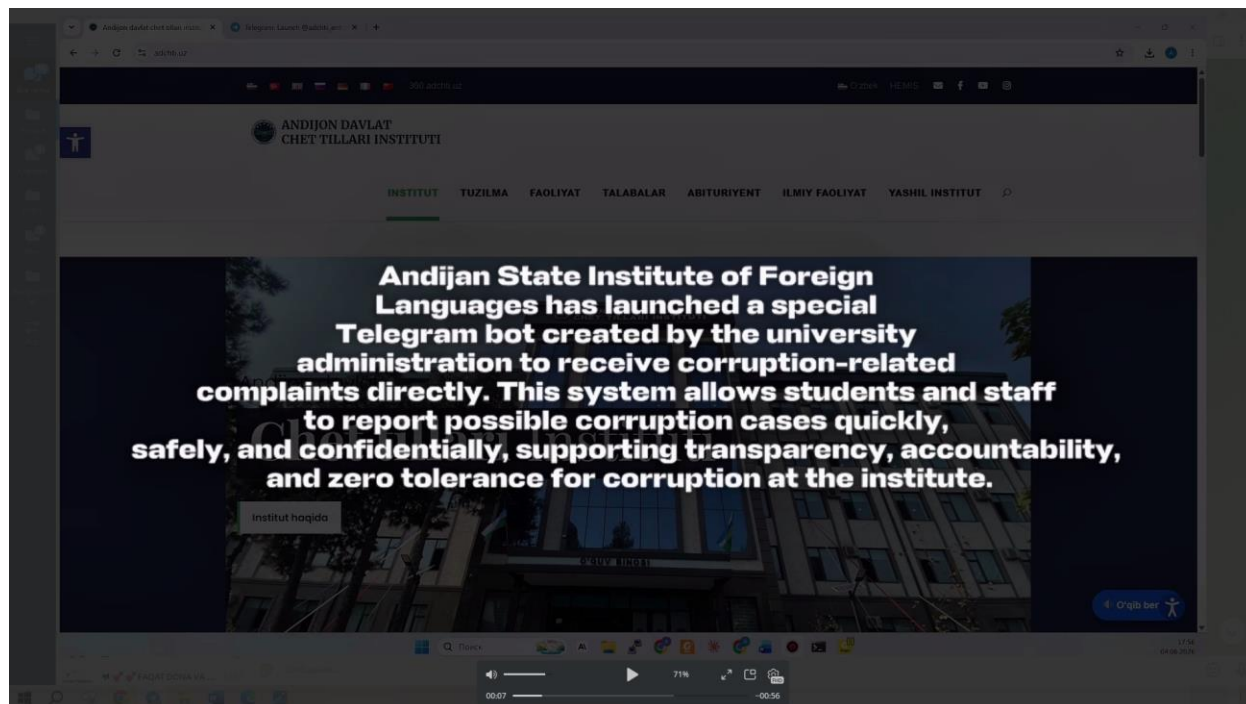
Documentation and Prevention

Video Instruction Evidence: ASIFL Anti-Corruption Complaint Telegram Bot

The video instruction demonstrates that ASIFL informs students and staff about a digital reporting channel for possible corruption cases. The bot supports quick, safe and confidential reporting and strengthens transparency, accountability and zero tolerance for corruption at the institute.

Anti-corruption complaint handling and integrity process

Step	Action	Explanation	Output
1	Report	A student, staff member or stakeholder submits a complaint through the Telegram bot, official contact channel, written appeal or responsible unit.	Report is received.
2	Register and classify	The complaint is recorded and classified by topic such as corruption risk, unethical behavior, conflict of interest, finance, procurement, harassment or service issue.	Case category and responsible unit are identified.
3	Review and verify	The relevant unit reviews facts, requests supporting evidence where necessary and protects confidentiality of personal information.	Complaint is verified and assigned for action.

4	Respond and correct	The responsible office prepares a response, corrective action or referral to competent authority when required.	Corrective or preventive measure is taken.
5	Improve integrity system	Repeated issues are analyzed to improve transparency, service quality, risk prevention and institutional accountability.	Governance and prevention measures are strengthened.

Description:

Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages (ASIFL) maintains an anti-corruption and integrity system that supports transparent governance, ethical conduct, accountability, responsible finance and a safe academic environment. The system combines a special Telegram complaint bot, official website and e-mail channels, written appeals, internal review procedures, the Code of Ethics and Code of Conduct, and responsible administrative units that receive and process complaints.

The anti-corruption system is designed to receive and review reports related to corruption risks, improper benefits, abuse of authority, conflict of interest, unethical behavior, financial or procurement concerns, academic or administrative service problems, harassment, discrimination and other issues affecting the rights and interests of students, staff and stakeholders. Reports are registered, classified, reviewed by the responsible unit and used for corrective or preventive action where necessary.

The integrity component of the system is supported by institutional rules, digital reporting, documentation and follow-up mechanisms. The ASIFL Code of Ethics and Code of Conduct establishes principles of integrity, justice, non-discrimination, respect, responsibility, accountability, transparency, academic integrity and prevention of corruption. The video instruction on the Telegram complaint bot demonstrates that the university communicates the reporting channel to students and staff and encourages confidential reporting of corruption-related concerns.
