

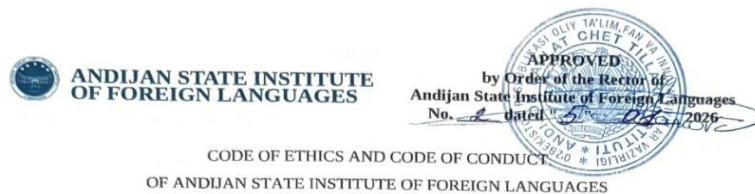

Code of Ethics rule at Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages

**Description:**

This document presents the written Code of Ethics and Code of Conduct of Andijan State Institute of Foreign Languages. The Code applies to university leaders, academic staff, administrative and support staff, researchers, and students. It defines the ethical values, professional standards, rules of conduct, types of violations, review procedures, and possible sanctions within the institute.

The document establishes the main principles of ethical behavior at ASIFL, including academic integrity, justice, non-discrimination, respect, responsibility, accountability, transparency, academic freedom, intercultural competence, and professional communication. It also explains the responsibilities of students, teachers, researchers, administrative staff, managers, and structural officials in maintaining a safe, fair, inclusive, and respectful educational environment.

The Code includes specific rules related to plagiarism, cheating, falsification, corruption, conflict of interest, misuse of institutional resources, confidentiality, social media conduct, respectful communication, research ethics, and the responsible use of digital, translation, and artificial intelligence tools. It also describes prohibited conduct and classifies violations as minor, moderate, or serious, with corresponding corrective measures and sanctions.

This evidence demonstrates that ASIFL has a formal institutional framework for promoting ethical governance, academic honesty, transparency, accountability, anti-corruption culture, and respectful behavior among all members of the university community. The Code supports responsible institutional management and contributes to the development of a safe, inclusive, and integrity-based academic environment.
